A practical hands-on workshop completing a series of art and craft tasks focussing on their community while exploring recycling.

The program can be run with groups of teachers or in a classroom alongside a teacher / assistant/ parent with the Drawing to Learn leader.

In 'don't throw it away' the group will explore their surroundings using recycled materials by...

- a. Creating figures of family, houses and a village/local community
- b. Telling a family story about their life in their home in the community/village.
- c. Giving an exhibition at the end of the final day.

The educational focus will be upon:

- Design/Make/appraise
- Cooperative learning strategies in group work
- Art/craft/designing and creating using a variety of recycled products.
- Integrated planning framework using 'tuning in, finding out, sorting out and going further' in exploration of what can be created with recycled products
- Cooperative learning strategies in group work
- Art/Craft/design. A different technique at each phase/task.
- Using levels of questioning to deepen the inquiry.
- Using the Australian curriculum to assist in exploring the inquiry question.
- Following a narrative structure to tell the family story.
- Using a publishing app/online tool to record the narrative.
- Integrating the project across the curriculum areas e.g., Literacy, Language, HASS, Science, ICT, Mathematics, Art and Craft and Design.

Costs.

Advertised 3-day program for staff from different sites is \$900 plus GST per person (resources required included). Costs for a school hosted workshop - whether with children or adults is \$3200 plus GST (cost of resources required are additional to cost of program)
